Current challenges

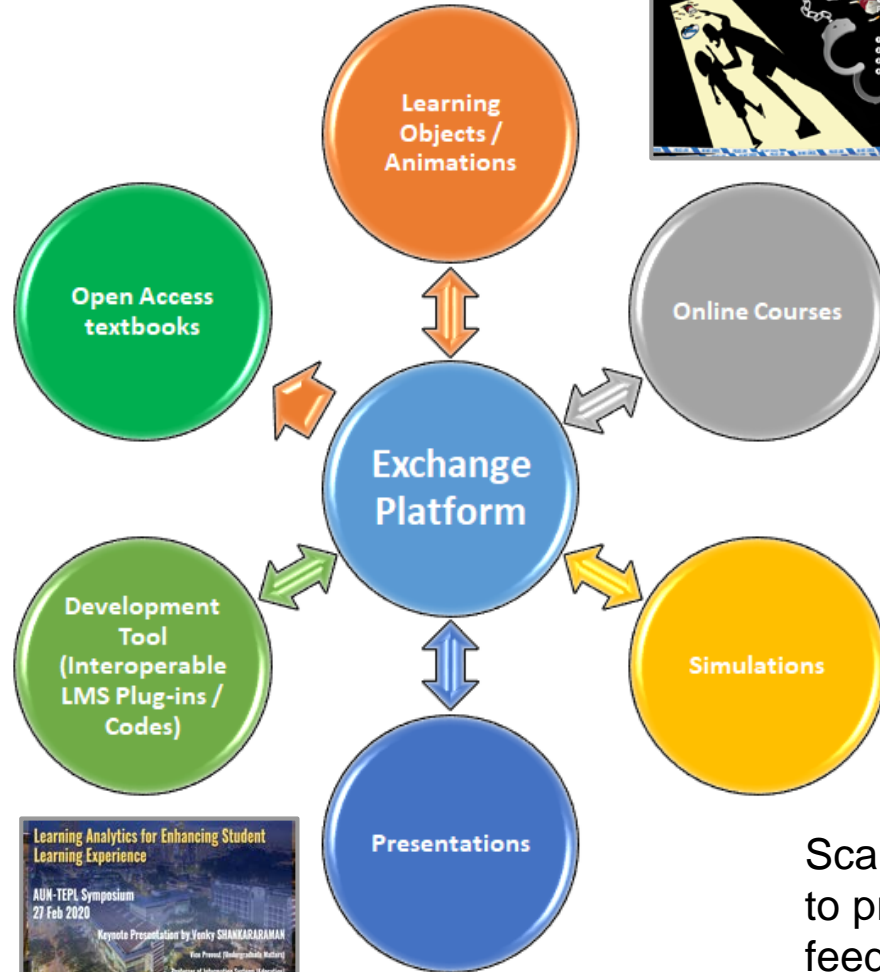
- No commonly used method for AUN+3 instructors to:

Proposal for sharing digital resources within AUN+3

1. Use MERLOT as an Exchange Platform



URL: [merlot.org](https://www.merlot.org)

- Widely known and reputable (established since 1997)
- Critical mass of digital resources available already
- Accommodates a wide variety of resources in different technical formats
- Incorporates user reviews, ratings, and other endorsement mechanisms
- Aligned with the [Creative Commons License](https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/) framework, a commonly accepted Intellectual Property regimes
- Integration with various Learning Management Systems (LMS)
- Allows sharing resources in different languages
- Initial tests and conversations indicate a strong alignment with AUN-TEPL goals and a willingness and ability to work with AUN-TEPL as a potential **MERLOT Community Partner** to meet AUN-TEPL's needs (e.g. support for professional development activities and access to a data analytics dashboard for reporting)

Proposal for sharing digital resources within AUN+3 (continued)

2. Leverage AUN-TEPL thematic network (symposia, website, webinars) to build related capabilities at AUN+3 universities
 - Work with centres for teaching, learning, and faculty development
 - Integration of methods into resources for instructors at AUN+3 members
 - Integration of methods into faculty development at AUN+3 members
 - Best practice sharing

3. Explore potential collaboration with AUNILO (Libraries of AUN) network
 - Integration into Library support of AUN+3 members
 - Best practice sharing

Next Steps

- Seeking **feedback** from the AUN-TEPL network members via Wooclap
- Circulate **draft proposal** after Symposium via email
- Obtain Steering Committee meeting approval (5 March 2020) for AUN TEPL thematic network to sign MOU with MERLOT to be a **Community Partner**
- In 2020, in collaboration with AUN libraries network, organize **Webinars and Symposium Presentations** (Aug 25-26) about the sharing of digital resources on MERLOT and the experience so far
- Track measures of success to report to AUN

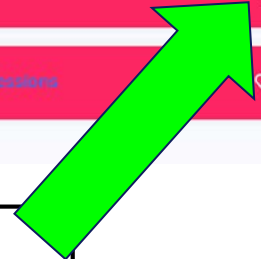
